Minutes of the previous meeting (9th May 2019) proposed by Inspr. Tom Waters, and seconded by Frank Cashman.

1. Matters Arising from Minutes. - None.

Discussions on correspondence received.

- Coole Park run – request for a further €700 in addition to €300 already requested and paid.
- Email from Coole Park parkrun requesting additional monies read to meeting.

Decision.

- Get full report on funding of parkruns for the future and draw up guidelines.
- Pay the €700 to Coole Park parkrun - proposed by Josephine Gardiner, seconded by Chris Hickey

2. Meeting with Sport Ireland.

Discussion.

- Meeting took place on the 17th July 2019 in GSP Offices.
- A worthwhile meeting.
- Monies available from Dormant Accounts for programmes and initiatives.
- GSP applied for a total of €129,716 in programme funding from Dormant Accounts for 2020.
- Could we ask Sean Canney, TD to attend our next meeting to discuss available funding?
- Who are the external funders for other LSP's.
- We should look for funding from GRD for projects.
- We should train more coaches – see Dublin example in association with NGB's
- Community Coaching is no longer restricted to Social Welfare recipients.

Decisions

- Send proposals for funding to Sean Canney TD, proposed by Gabriel Cronnelly, seconded by Kieran Coyne.
- Identify new projects for Dormant Accounts funding for the future.
- Use Community Coaching funding in our account to train coaches, thereby increasing our capacity – proposed by David Lee, seconded by John O'Donnell

3. Position of SIDO.

Discussion.

- Meeting has to take place between both Local Authorities in Galway on the future of GSP – hosting, staffing etc.
- We can re-direct funding from different programmes now in our workplan, to employ a SIDO on a 3- month contract – November to ends of January 2020.
- Is there a workplan in place for the SIDO?
- Person should be in place for final 3 months of 2019 so that they are ready for full contract in January 2020.
- We need 'right' person appointed in the position.
- Can we advertise in November for 1 yr contract?
- The SIDO will work exclusively with People with Disabilities. We do need a SIDO in Galway.

Decision

- Do not advertise now, await funding for the position in 2020 from S.I., then advertise.
- Take the four staff members that will be funded by Sport Ireland and then look for funding from other sources to fund extra positions if required – proposed by David Lee, seconded by Chris Hickey.

On Staffing generally –

Discussion

- S.I. have committed to funding 4 staff – Coordinator, Administrator, Community Sports Development Officer and Sports Inclusion Disability Officer.
- If we want more staff than that outlined above, we will have to find the resources locally.

4. Club Development Funding 2019.

- This programme has been advertised.
- Applies to clubs who are in existence for one year or less.

- Ba ceart duinn na ceithre baill a bhfeith maoinithe ag Spóirt Éireann a glacadh, agus ansin cuardaigh maoiniú ó foinse eile do na postanna eile más gá – mholtaithe ag David Lee, cuidithe ag Chris Hickey.
