

Universal Superloo Daily Checklist (Hydra/Pillar Models)

1. Technical Area Door opening
2. Drain Bottom Tank
3. Paper dispenser opening and paper quantity
4. Lift and hose under floor
5. Changeover to manual (Switch)
6. Public door open
7. Check and clean public area
8. Cleaning of support bars, mirror and door
9. Cleaning of bowl
10. Check floor detectors for 4 kg
11. Check floor detectors for 25 kg
12. Switch to automatic and check unit completes a cycle
13. Empty the rubbish bin
14. Check the dispensing of soap and disinfectant
15. Check and clean the coin slot mechanism
16. Read the meters, close the coiner door
17. Check the external appearance of the toilet
18. Fill in the monthly sheet
19. Lubricate the washing mechanism
20. Lubricate the drying jet guide
21. Check the filling of the water tank
22. Close the technical door
23. Insert a coin and check unit functions correctly
24. Check voice message button
25. Check the operation of the hand wash (Soap, water, drying)
26. Check illumination of information panel
27. Check coiner panel illumination
28. Check unit is in "vacant" before leaving

Universal Superloo Monthly Checklist

1. Cleaning upper tank
2. Lubricate all moving parts
3. Check settings and adjust motors and tolerances
4. Remove internal floors, clean and reset

Fault Reporting

1. Bowl in washing position
2. Bowl in use position
3. Drying duct descent
4. Drying duct ascent
5. Bowl detector
6. Drying duct detector
7. Public door detector
8. 25kg without 4kg
9. Handle activated without detection
10. Water circuit
11. Trap blocked
12. 2 level detector
13. Coiner doors open
14. Coiner fault
15. Coiner cycle
16. Temperature sensor
17. Operating normally
18. Heating system
19. Public door opening
20. Public door closing
21. Bowl water tank refilling
22. Fire alarm
23. Detection during the washing cycle
24. Inoccupation (not used for more than 6hrs)
25. Abuse occupation
26. Technical or public door open during the night
27. Manual mode, technical door closed
28. Night closing
29. Door open during the day
